GED General Education Development Tests





EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING

Do you have a child between the ages of 3 to 5 years? Early childhood developmental screening helps a school district identify children who may benefit from district and community resources available to help in their development. Early Childhood Developmental Screening includes a vision screening that helps detect potential eye problems, but is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam. Your child must be screened in order to attend School Readiness, Head Start or Kindergarten in Minnesota Public Schools.

Lakeview offers Early Childhood Screening at least four times a year. Screening packets will be mailed to all eligible families we have on our census. Make sure to give us a call and have your child's name added to our census or fill out the census form found in our newsletter. If you have questions, please call 507-423-5164 Ext 1320.
