This is a program which prepares students to pass the examination for a national high school equivalency diploma that includes a set of four computer based tests (Reading through Language Arts, Mathematical Reasoning, Social Studies, and Science).

Early childhood developmental screening helps a school district identify children who may benefit from district and community resources available to help in their development. Early Childhood Developmental Screening includes a vision screening that helps detect potential eye problems, but is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam. Your child must be screened in order to attend School Readiness, Head Start or Kindergarten in Minnesota Public Schools.

Lakeview offers Early Childhood Screening at least four times a year. Screening packets will be mailed to all eligible families we have on our census.
